PLEASE NOTE: I stand corrected. SPADD did not have to file an open records request to receive the waiver re-write application. DCH did finally provide this document to them but it is not on the DCH website for public review. Sorry for the confusion. Heidi

I'm sorry to write to you during the holiday time frame but unfortunately, something has come to my attention that needs **IMMEDIATE ACTION**. On Wednesday, December 16 the Board for the Dept. of Community Health (DCH) approved to go forward with the COMP waiver re-write application. By law, they are supposed to have a 30 day public comment period. They are only allowing 2 weeks public comment and this is during the holiday season!

Public comment is scheduled **Wednesday, December 22, 2015, at 10:30** a.m., at the Department of Community Health (2 Peachtree Street, N.W., Atlanta, Georgia 30303) in the 5th Floor Board Room. Individuals who are disabled and need assistance to participate during this meeting should call (404) 656-4479.

So here is what I need for you to do:

 Submit any comments and concerns you have regarding the COMP Waiver rewrite to DCH by 12/31/15. Comment in writing on any of the proposed changes should do so on or before **December 29, 2015**, to the Board of Community Health, Post Office Box 38406, Atlanta, Georgia 30334. (**NO email address was provided- this is another issue**).

- 2. Contact Gil Silva, Deputy Regional Administrator for the CMS Atlanta Regional Office to express your concerns with lack of time to review the documents (less than 30 days), lack of information (including the entire waiver re-write application) posted on DCH website AND lack of overall communication regarding the waiver to everyone impacted. - In addition, please copy your email of concern to Jackie Glaze, Associate Regional Administrator which oversees the oversight and technical assistance for State Medicaid including Medicaid Waiver Program Development. E- mail address is: ROATLMCD@cms.hhs.gov (phone: 404-562-7359).

I have just started to review the entire document and did find one issue that I have concerns about. Under participate direction (self directed) services. The waiver application **DOES NOT** allow families the right to utilize "Personal Assistance Retainer" like providers. This is not fair and families should have the same rights to be able to retain their employees as providers. Please make a note of that in your comments to DCH! As I discover more comments in my review or from others, I will let you know.

In addition, I did want you to know that I've been appointed by Governor Deal to be on the Georgia Council for Developmental Disabilities. I look forward to representing all of you as we continue to make positive change for individuals with DD in the State of Georgia!

I hope you find this information helpful and continue to advocate and speak up during this COMP waiver re-write in 2015-16.

Please note, most of the changes proposed in the COMP waiver will be carried over into the NOW waiver as well. Stay tuned for more information and how you can get involved. Happy Holidays!
