Psychotherapy Scholarships Available for Mothers of Children with Special Needs.

Mothers of children with special needs typically meet their own needs last. Although the stress levels are often very high, these women tend to allot financial resources for various therapies for their children and ignore their own needs for support.

Licensed psychotherapists in the Atlanta area are collaborating in a research study designed to gather and analyze empirical data pertaining to Interface Therapy. This group offers scholarships to individuals who are willing to participate in their research. Individuals who agree to participate in the research will be asked to complete two questionnaires at the beginning of treatment and then again at the end of 15 sessions. Completion of the questionnaires is the only difference between participation in the research project and being a non-research-participant client. All rights of confidentiality apply. Data is reported without identifying information. The clients who participate in the research will receive a scholarship for psychotherapy which reduces the therapy rate. In addition to the scholarship which provides a reduced fee, a portion of the rate the client pays for therapy may also be reimbursable by health insurance.

Interface Therapy is a progressive therapeutic approach that offers clients an opportunity for a comprehensively positive transformative experience. It is utilized in addressing a number of emotional and psychological challenges, including trauma responses, anxiety, depression, limiting thoughts, and existential issues. It is effective in treating stress-related problems such as apprehension, edginess, uncertainty, sadness, hopelessness, irritability, worry, and moodiness.

Interface Therapy combines standard psychological practice with subtle energy healing techniques. In conjunction with psychological methodology, Interface Therapy works with the human energy system to balance and realign areas where tension, unprocessed emotion, distorted cognition, and limiting beliefs have been held in the physical and energetic bodies. This integration yields a holistic treatment system that supports the client in drawing upon his/her natural healing ability.
