Dearest Advocates:

I guess the exhaustion of taking care of child with cancer (and multiple disabilities) has set in....I have made a mistake and wanted you to know. I have been notified by Jerry Dubberly (Chief of Medicaid Division of Dept of Community Health) that the newsletter I sent out earlier today is wrong. Apparently, this public notice is **NOT** regarding the recent provider rate study for the NOW/COMP Disability waivers but for actually adding three additional rates to the COMP waiver. (This was not in the text of the Public notice)

I still believe that their needs to be a similar process to allow families the ability to comment in a public hearing regarding the provider rate study. This is why it is so important that they become more transparent with their intentions and notifications so families know about changes directly from THEM. Communication is the key to success.

Once again, I am sorry. I do make mistakes.
